REDLANDS AND OLYMPIC FC

Redlands United bounced back into winning form after 2 draws in the NPL Men's competition. Friday evening they played host to Olympic FC at Compass Grounds in Round 13 of the NPL Men's competition and 2 1st half goals were enough to take the competition points.

A goal each from Guil Santana and Ryo Emoto in the 1st half and some dogged, last ditch defending saw the Red Devils secure a 2-1 victory over Olympic FC.

Some spectators weren't even in their seats before the Red Devils were on the scoreboard through Santana in less than 1 minute.

Straight from the kick off, Redlands gathered possession and moved the ball forward in a sweeping move before the ball rebounded out to Santana whose 1st time volley dipped over the keeper and into the net leaving the home fans ecstatic with only 54 seconds on the clock.

Olympic continued to press forward and were on the scoresheet after 10 minutes when Redlands were unable to cut out a ball into the box leaving Keeper Ryan Govan with little chance to stop the close range shot allowing Olympic to level the scores at 1 apiece.

From this point on Redlands controlled the ball and managed Olympics attacking 1st half forays. Just under the half hour mark the Red Devils were awarded a penalty when Dylan Brent's driven cross into the goal mouth produced a hand ball as the defender dueled for the ball with Peter Klaassen. Emoto stepped up to the penalty spot and made no mistake to give the Red Devils the lead 2-1.

Redlands, who were already missing 2 of their normal starting defenders, were dealt a blow when Brent was forced off a minute later leaving the Red Devils missing 3 of their starting defenders. Young Deane Alterio filled in for Brent admirably in an unfamiliar role.

Redlands had a scare before half time when a miscalculation by Govan on a long ball by Olympic required Sam Langley to clear the ball off the line and settle the play down.

When the 2nd half commenced the game continued in the same manner, with the majority of play in Olympic's territory and trying to catch Redlands on the counter attack. Govan was called into action to deny a couple of shots. With a good share of possession the Red Devils created a number of chances but were unable to properly break down Olympic's defense and make the opportunities count.

As the game entered its final stages Olympic increased their efforts but Redlands defense maintained their form and with keeper Govan marshalling his troops the Red Devils were able to repel the attacking forays and even created further opportunities, however the game finished with Redlands picking up the win with a 2-1 result picking up valuable competition points.

Redlands' Fiction Bar and Restaurant, Man of the Match was awarded to Michael Lee for a strong performance in midfield.

After the game Redlands United Head Coach Daniel Varma commented, "Evolution... there have been multiple occasions this season against teams who currently occupy the top four where we have, in my view outplayed our opposition for the majority of matches but dropped points. So tonight it was fitting that although we didn't put on our best performance we found a way to win. In saying that and upon review we definitely had better chances. A team can only win in this manner if they have matured, if they have evolved."

"For the few lucky enough to be a part of our dressing room, I would expect them to say that our togetherness is palpable. Each team member selfless and committed to our confidential goals as a squad."

"A very special mention to my assistant coach Griffin Mansfield-Taylor for the intonation displayed in his key suggestion i had pre planned tonight at a pivotal point in the match. Often a voice of calm in times that can be turbulent in this occupation. Also on field to our former Manchester United youth player Michael Lee for a best on ground performance and to Deane Alterio who performed beyond his years and showed further versatility after coming on as an early substitute. One game to the National Round of 32 of the Australia Cup and now 2pts off the top four. Our football. Our way." Varma said
